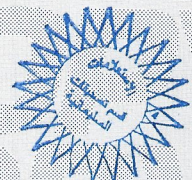

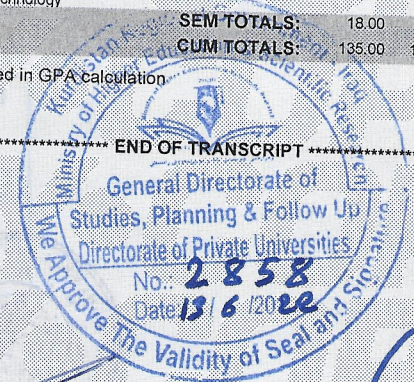

ACCREDITATION

American University of Iraq, Sulaimani is recognized by the Republic of Iraq's Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and also recognized by Kurdistan Regional Government's Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

CREDIT

One credit represents 60 weekly minutes of classroom time for a 13-week semester. An undergraduate student must earn at least 120 credits to graduate while an MBA student must successfully complete 17 courses.

GRADES

Course grades are reported as letters using the 4.0 grade point system to calculate the cumulative average. Credit for undergraduate courses is awarded for any grade of D or better. Credit for graduate courses is awarded for any grade of C or better. The following is a table of the letter grades and their numerical equivalents:

- I** = Incomplete. No credit is awarded and no effect on cumulative average.
- W** = Withdrawn. No credit is awarded and no effect on cumulative average.
- WF** = Withdrawal Fail. Student withdrew after withdrawal period. No credit is awarded and no effect on cumulative GPA.
- P** = Pass (work meritorious of D or better on undergraduate courses only). No credit is awarded but affects cumulative average. Credits count toward graduation.
- F** = Fail. No credit is awarded but affects cumulative average.

Undergraduates must have a cumulative average of 2.0 to graduate. Graduate students must have a cumulative average of 3.0.

HONORS

President's List (2014 and after) /Provost's List (Prior to 2014) – Awarded to any undergraduate student with a semester grade point average of 3.75 (President) or 3.70 (Provost) or above for a minimum of 12 credit hours.

Dean's List - Awarded to any undergraduate student with a semester grade point average of 3.50 to 3.74 or above for a minimum of 12 credit hours.

GRADUATION HONORS

The following honors are awarded to undergraduate students upon graduation based on cumulative grade point average:

- Cum Laude – 3.40 GPA
- Magna Cum Laude – 3.60 GPA
- Summa Cum Laude – 3.80 GPA

RECORDING OF COURSES AND REPEAT COURSES

All attempts of a given course will appear on the official transcript with the grade(s) earned, however only the highest retake grade and credits will be used for the calculation of GPA. The course being retaken must be the same course first taken, unless the course is no longer offered at AUIS.

TRANSFER CREDITS

Generally, college-level courses completed at regionally-accredited institutions will transfer, provided that grades of at least a "C" (2.0) are earned and the course is similar in content and scope to work offered at AUIS, as determined by the Department Chair.

A student may earn up to 60 credits of transfer credit. All transfer credits are marked as "Transfer Credits" on transcript.
